

Climate Changes in Barcelos

- ✓ Like all over the planet, the effects of global warming are the environmental problems which affect Barcelos the most;
- ✓ Global Warming is caused by the increase of greenhouse gases;
- ✓ The greenhouse effect is inevitable, because without it life on earth would be impossible, however, when it becomes uncontrolled, it causes environmental imbalances;
- ✓ Unfortunately, current technology is not developed enough, so that greenhouse gases can be reduced.

Main Events

Just like everywhere else on the planet, the city of Barcelos also suffered from climate changes, such as:

- The arrival of new of animal and vegetable species;
- Weather Disturbances.





Motor vehicles

- ✓ As in all developed countries, motor vehicles are the main vehicles used in Portugal.
- ✓ These means of transportation emit large quantities of polluting gases into the atmosphere.
- ✓ In 2015, in Portugal, an average of 53,868.5 tonnes co2 was issued.
- ✓ Fortunately, there are alternatives to this problem, like electric cars!
- ✓ Nevertheless, not everyone can afford to buy that kind of cars...



Burnings

- ✓ Burnings consist of burning vegetable materials and sometimes also plastics.
- ✓ This is an activity performed, especially during Autumn, mainly by older people.
- ✓ They do it almost unconsciously since they do not think about its impact on the environment, that is, contributing to the increase of greenhouse gases in the atmosphere ...



Trash on the streets

Household/domestic discharges

✓ Unfortunately and despite being illegal, in Barcelos they make household/domestic discharges into the river ...

Introduction and expansion of new species in Portuguese territory

- ✓ The hot and cold air streams are changing, just like the ocean currents and animals'
 migratory travels. Due to that, the area of their comfortable temperature zone is
 changing.
- ✓ As a result, in Barcelos, there are new species never seen before, a phenomenon that happens worldwide and which is aused by global warming.



Water Hyacinth

- This aquatic plant was brought to Barcelos from the Amazon rainforest and its an invasive species.
- ✓ Domestic water feeds the Water Hyacinth.
- ✓ Causing a high impact on other living beings, it can suffocate fish and prevent them from ingesting their usual aliment.
- √The Water Hyacinth increased because there is a bigger concentration of nutrients due to the drop of water level, which was not accompanied by a drop in water temperature.

Impact of climate changes in Barcelos

- * Forest destruction;
- * Pollution of the river Cávado;
- * Reduction of river water level;
- * Changes in rainfall patterns;
- * Floods.

Agriculture and Livestock Farming in the County of Barcelos

The Benefits:

- * The economic value 45M/month
- * Job creation
- * Community Enrichment
- * Food production (milk and meat)

Disadvantages:

- * High consumption of drinkable water;
- * The release of greenhouse gases, CH4;
- * Erosion of soils (drought and abrasion by ruminant);
- * Increased use of pesticides
- * Non-sustainable farm:
 - Biodiversity decrease and
 - Increase of transgenic products
 - Increase in the use of pesticides
